EMERGENCY EVACUATION WAIVER OF ANIMAL MOVEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Due to the large number of animals in harm's way this hurricane season, the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Animal Industry, has temporarily suspended intrastate requirements for those animals fleeing the affected areas. In addition, Georgia and Alabama have waived the interstate requirements for Florida livestock fleeing the potential impact areas of the storms.

Anyone transporting livestock must continue to stop at the Florida agricultural interdiction stations. If proper paperwork does not accompany the shipment, the transporter will be issued a movement document at the interdiction station. This movement document must be carried during transport to Georgia or Alabama and for return back into Florida.
